- Enhanced cleaning with disinfection ethanol, etc
- Regular disinfecting to door-nobs, elevator buttons, and escalator handrails, where visitors often touch with their hands

- Signboard for prevention of infection and notice of limited usage in smoking rooms, where high infection risk, so called 3 Cs, - close spaces, crowded places and close-contact settings, might be appeared.

- Notice to office tenants
- Cooperation with Local health office
- Sanitary cleaning in the office floor and public spaces (toilets, escalator and elevator)
