Conducts Accident Response Drill

On November 11 2020, IINO conducted the joint accident response drill with IINO Marine Service Co., LTD. ("IMS").

The drill was conducted under the following two assumptions to understand the issues

- (1) A dry bulk carrier (hereinafter "the vessel") owned by IINO and managed by IMS ran aground and bunker oil was leaked to the sea
- (2) Emergency response using an online tool to prevent COVID-19 infection

A summary of the drill is provided below.

09:30JST The vessel ran aground and leaked oil while sailing off the Philippine coast

10:00JST IINO deemed this case to be a serious accident and set up the emergency headquarters and notified employees who were at work and employees who were working from home of the accident and confirmed accident site information in cooperation with the relevant parties.

10:30JST In addition to collecting information and responding to the accident, IINO shared information with other organizations and responded to inquiries from outside the company.

11:30JST End of the drill
